FSK students require this course as a means to gain some great skills around the working world, as well as to gain 4 QCE credit points. Attendance is so important, as unfinished courses gain you no qualifications and no QCE credits. Those four credits could be the difference between a QCE or no QCE at the end of Year 12. Please ensure that the young people are attending school and training courses every day or they are at risk of not getting their Queensland Certificate of Education at the end of Year 12.

### Health Services Course

Doug from Strategix Training came into carry out the induction for students interested in the Certificate II in Health Services. This certificate is an informative and practical qualification with topics that are current with the health care industry; individual needs planning, health and well-being strategies. This certificate is the first step toward positions like nursing assistant, personal carer and aged care worker and allows the students to have a look at this sector for a potential lifetime career.

On Monday and Wednesday last week we had Matt and Henry, Academy Program Officers from The Johnathan Thurston Academy, attend our school and carry out the JTConnect/ JTSucceed session with our students who are potentially looking to transition to work.
