BUSY Schools Cairns has organised for our Year 12 Students to partake in the "Tenancy Skills Course" in term 4. We hope to book regular sessions in 2024 for our new and continuing yr 11 and 12 students. This course is for anyone over 16 years of age, looking to move into rentals, share houses or student accommodation.

The short course takes around 10hrs to complete. Upon completion you will receive a certificate that is recognised by Real Estates, RTA and REIQ to help your application get ahead.

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## CAIRNS REGIONAL COUNCIL APPRENTICESHIPS

As the end of the school term is rapidly approaching, I wanted to send a brief email to inform you that we will soon be announcing our apprenticeship and traineeship opportunities for commencement in January 2024. Unfortunately, I am unable to provide the exact number of available positions at this moment as we are awaiting confirmation regarding our recent Skilling Queenslanders for Work (SQW) funding application. Once we have received the necessary details, I will promptly share additional information, including a list of the job openings and instructions on how to apply. What I can confirm is that we will be recruiting for the following positions regardless (there may be 6 SQW roles added to this also):

- 1 x electrical apprenticeship
- 1 x plumbing apprenticeship (potentially 2)
- 1 x Fitting & Turning apprenticeship
- 2 x School Based traineeships (business based)
- 2 x fulltime business traineeships

For this intake we will be running two vacancy information sessions – one for the apprenticeship vacancies and one for the traineeship vacancies. The 26th of September is tentatively earmarked for this at this stage however, this could change if we have not heard yet about the SQW bid. Although our information session date is yet to be confirmed, we are happy to take registrations now.
