

Consent to Share and Obtain Information

Personal and health information to support learning

To assist young people facing a range of barriers to learning to achieve their education program goals, through the provision of a range of strategies and specialised support, students at The BUSY Schools complete standardised diagnostic assessments to gain insight about their literacy, numeracy and employability skills. Additionally, The BUSY Schools engages organisations such as, but not limited to, BUSY Health Practitioners to conduct individualised assessments to gain information about mental health and wellbeing. Information gained from these assessments assists in the development of informed individualised learning plans.

At times The BUSY Schools may engage services provided by:

- allied and other health professionals
- · psychologists and guidance officers
- youth and social workers.

Collecting personal and health information

Personal and health information is collected to assist your young person by:

- · providing direct support or intervention to individuals or groups of students to address barriers to learning and engagement
- undertaking various assessments (eg cognitive, speech and language, psychosocial) to identify additional learning needs
- planning for individual educational needs.

On occasions you or your young person may speak about other members of your family or other people. This means personal or health information may be collected about people other than you or your young person while providing services.

Examples of personal and health information that may be collected are:

- you or your young person's name, address, contact details
- medical information
- other material required to conduct appropriate tests
- test results, school reports and other information generated by the school
- physical, mental psychological or other health information about you or your young person
- details about you or your young person's disability
- express wishes about the future provision of health services, from you or your young person
- health services that have been provided, or to be provided
- genetic information about you or your young person which is or could be predictive of the health of you or your young person
- any information necessary for the provision of required services.
